The exercise took place at the disaster management centre, a former military area, in Cuxhaven-Altenwalde. The objective was to install emergency drinking water supply for the local population in case of extensive flooding. Especially impressive was the collaboration of different emergency personnel and the technical equipment from heavy duty trucks to high-tech recon drones with thermal imaging. Soon the storm surge season starts and Cuxhaven is prepared.
