

About the library

The library was founded in 1907, but was completely destroyed during WW2. In May 2004, the *library of Mineralogy and Petrography Institute* was taken over and included. We supply mainly students and scholars of the participating institutes. Guests are always welcome.

Services

We provide literature in the fields of *paleontology*, *sedimentology*, *mineralogy*, *petrography*, *tectonics*, *regional geology and more*.

We are holding about 150 journals on a regular basis. In addition, we have about 22,000 maps and 1200 aerial photographs.

By combining the resources of the Institute of Geology and the Institute of Mineralogy and Petrography, the books still have three different classifications. The holdings are listed in the beluga-catalogue (beluga.sub.uni-hamburg.de), but not yet completely. Please ask us, if you cannot find a particular book / map.

We also offer a wide range of electronic journals via the Elektronische Zeitschriftenbibliothek (EZB) (rzblx1.uni-regensburg.de/ezeit).

Individual introductions to the library and the catalogue are possible at any time.

Usage and loan

The Library of the Institute of Geology is a freely accessible library. Borrowing is only possible after consultation.

There is no user ID of the library system of the University of Hamburg required for the loan. However, it can be issued by us.

Please bring your student card and identity card for the library card registration and issuing.
